I refer to the consultation on the LDP draft Plan Strategy. Please note that this response represents the views of the Planning department of Mid and East Antrim Borough Council. It has not been possible to clear this response through Council Members because of the current period of purdah in advance of the Council elections on 2 May.

Our comments are restricted solely to cross boundary matters between our respective Councils.

We note the proposed Special Countryside Area (SCA) designation at Lough Neagh / Lough Beg and Lower River Bann, as shown on District Proposals Map 1d. MEA will also be taking full account of the importance of the Lough Beg and Lower Bann fringes, both in environmental and landscape terms, in bringing forward our draft Plan Strategy.

Accordingly, we welcome the principle of protecting such lands on both sides of the Council boundary. The mechanisms proposed for this have been the subject of previous discussion between our respective Council planning staff. Whilst opinions on this may differ in part, it is nevertheless our view that the approach of both councils is fundamentally sound and provides a good example of joined up working between our councils.

In regard to your delineation of the SCA boundary as it applies to Lough Beg, we note that this stops at the lough shore. We consider it would be better if this were to extend to the Council boundary running down the middle of Lough Beg, so as to ensure complete continuity in the joint approach.
