Retail NI support the Sequential Test, but fail to consider the position and role of the Oaks District Centre in the retailing hierarchy of Dungannon.			
Retail NI provide no evidence to support the case than an edge of centre location should be reduced to 150-200m. This would exclude the Oaks Centre from being an edge of centre location and would open up the opportunity for out of town locations.			
It would be inappropriate to reduce the edge of centre definition in the absence of a robust Retail Capacity Study and an assessment of potential sites to meet future need.			
Similarly, in the absence of a Retail Capacity Study, there is no justification to amend the floorspace thresholds from 1,000 sq m to 500 sq m.
