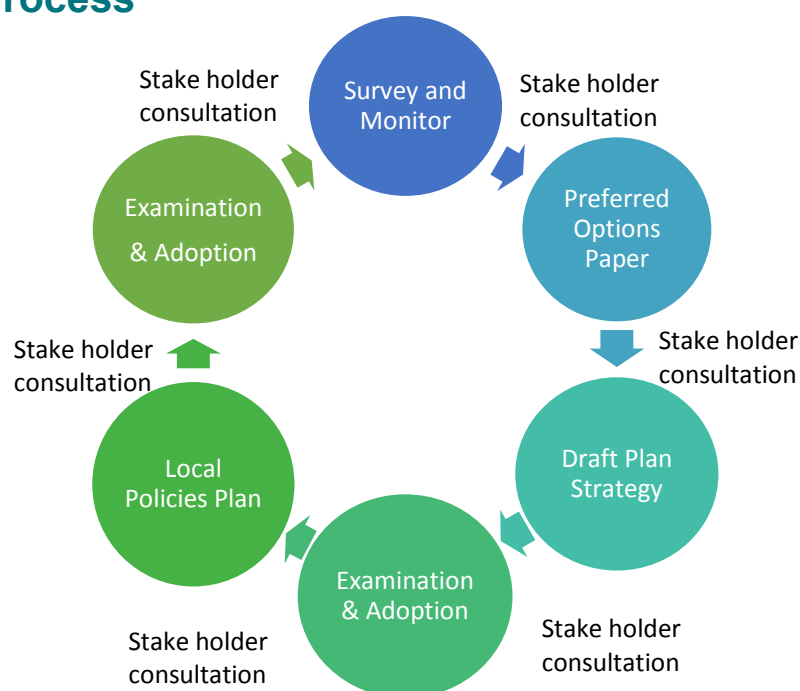

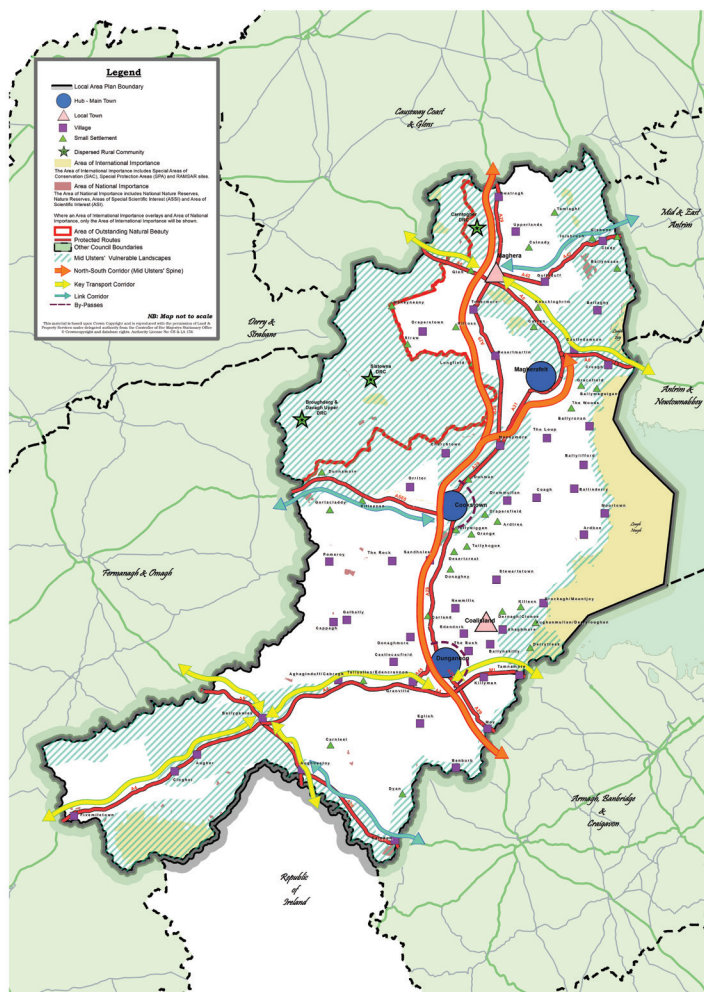
The Plan Process



Our Growth Strategy and Spatial Framework seeks to:

- Manage growth based on a settlement hierarchy.
- Focus growth on Cookstown, Dungannon and Magherafelt.
- Industrial lands to address acute shortage of industrial land in Dungannon
 - additional zonings at Granville and North Dungannon.
- Consolidate Coalisland and Maghera.
- Maintain and consolidate villages as local service centres.
- Provide development opportunities within smaller settlements.
- Accommodate development within the countryside that supports the community without causing harm.
- Support rural regeneration in remoter areas through Dispersed Rural Communities.
- Improve public and private transportation, provide for railways and upgrading of the road network.
- Facilitate improvements to A29 which acts as the transportation spine of Mid Ulster and other trunk roads.
- Protect vulnerable landscapes and conservation interests.
